Please note that this document serves as a guideline only. There can be variations as the vehicle categories can consist of numerous different vehicle models. No specific vehicle model can be confirmed in advance or guaranteed at any time.

Weight	Up to 9 kg	9 - 30 kg	Under 18 kg	Over 18 kg
Direction Facing	Rear	Rear if under 9 kg Rear or Front, if over 9 kg Front, if over 18 kg	Front-facing child seat	Booster seat
no car seat required for children over 145 cm				

NOTE: Children within weight range 9 kg to 18 kg should be kept rear-facing as long as possible.

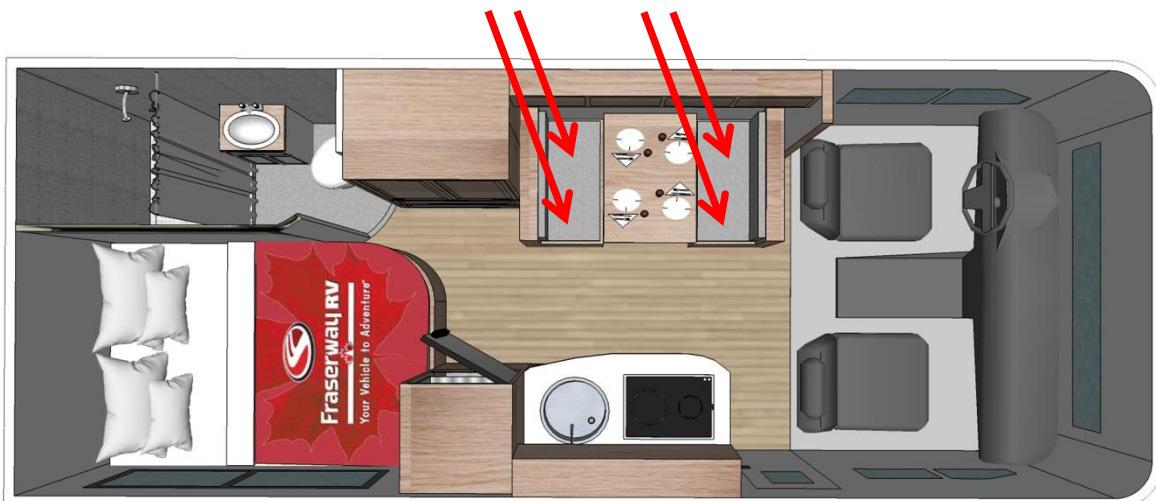

C-XLarge Motorhome

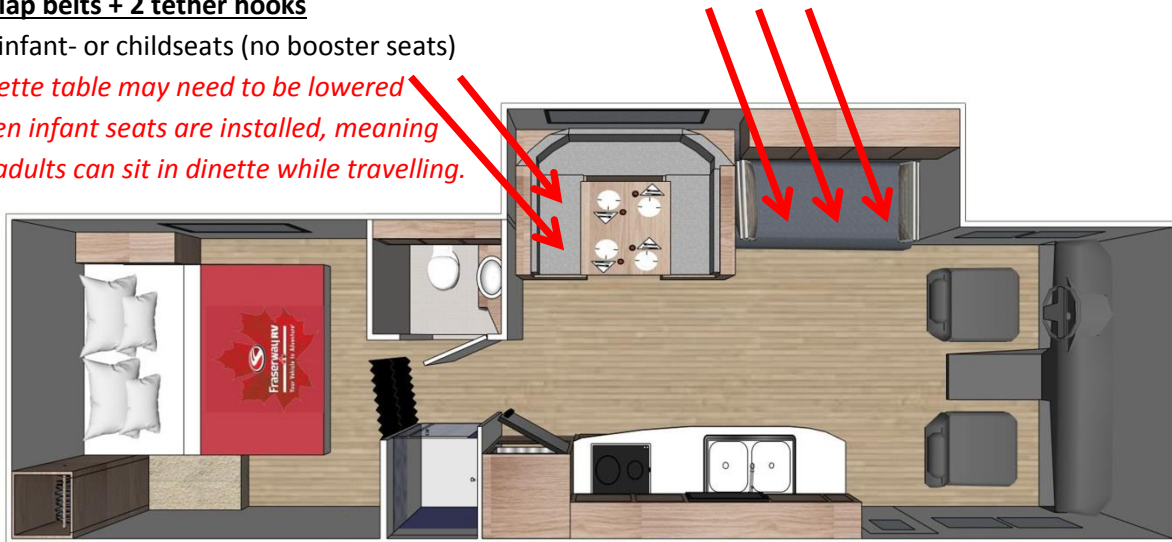
2 x lap belts + 2 tether hooks

A-Class Motorhome

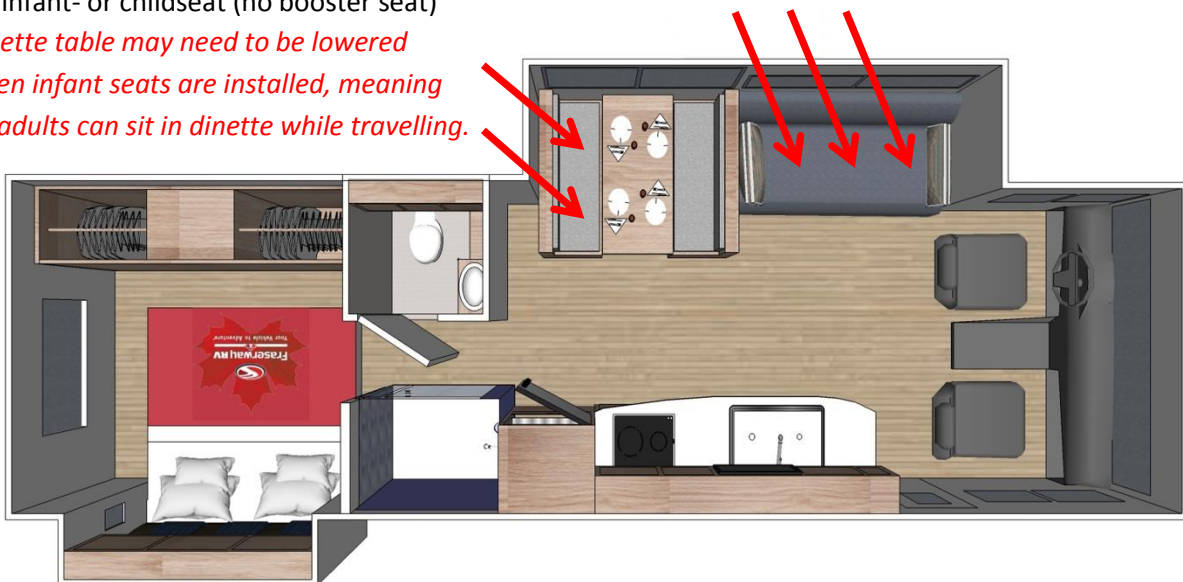
2 x lap belts + 1 tether hook

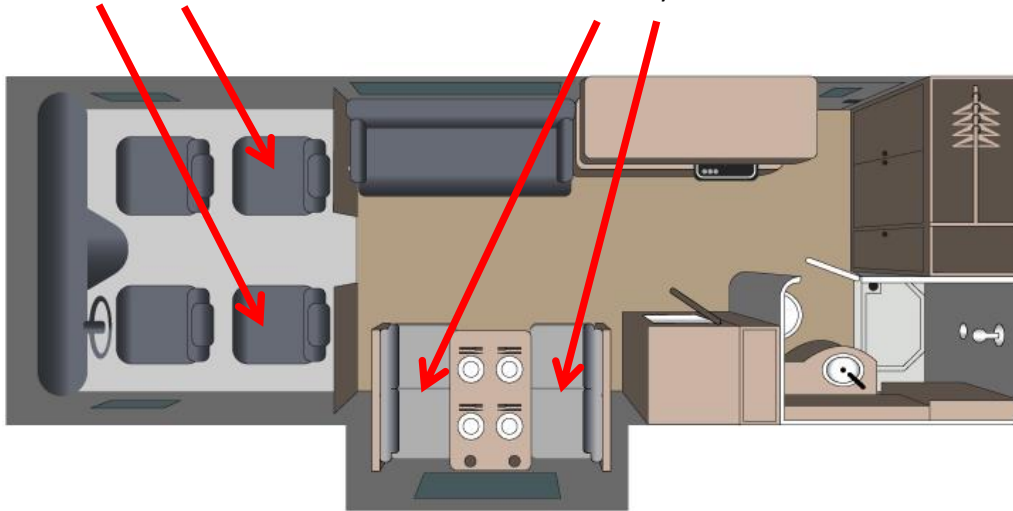
Adventurer 4 Motorhome

MH27' Wheelchair Accessible

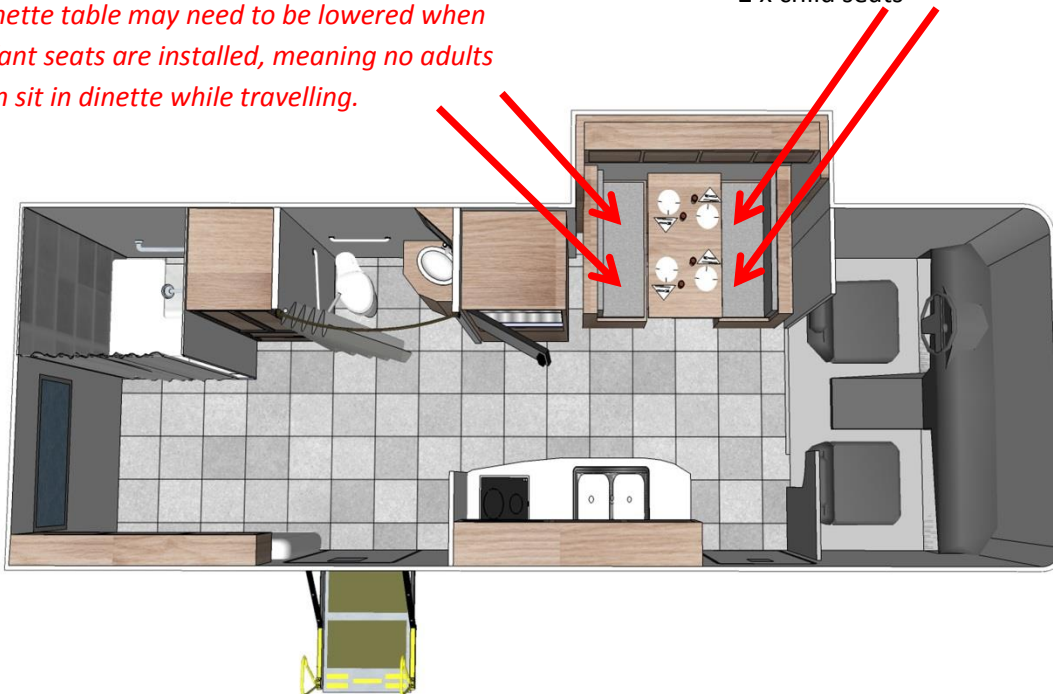
2 x lap belts + 2 tether hooks
